

Privacy Statement

The company Slicing Packing Fun & Many More SA (hereinafter referred to as the company) attaches great importance to the protection of your personal data and that your privacy is respected.

In this privacy statement, we want to provide clear and transparent information about what data we collect and how we handle personal data. We make every effort to ensure your privacy and therefore handle personal data with care. The company adheres in all cases to the applicable laws and regulations, including the General Data Protection Regulation.

Personal data

Personal data is only collected when you communicate it yourself on an expressly voluntary basis, for example through the contact form on our website. When providing this personal data, you are asked to consent to the collection and processing of the personal data for website management and analysis, direct marketing and to keep you informed via newsletter or invitation.

The Company may ask to provide personal information when you make a request for example to receive information, to be invited to our events or if you make other inquiries or requests. This information may include contact details (e.g. name, email, phone...) and information related to your request. In such cases, the firm will only process your information to the extent necessary to process and respond to your question or request. The firm may also seek your consent to process this information for other purposes which it will then expressly communicate.

If you have agreed to receive a newsletter or invitation, you authorize the company to follow up on your responses to our communications.

This entails that we will in any case:

Process your personal data in accordance with the purpose for which they are provided, these purposes and types of personal data are described in this privacy statement,
Processing your personal data is limited to only those data that are minimally necessary for the purposes for which they are processed,
Asking for your explicit consent if we need it for processing your personal data,
Have taken appropriate technical and organizational measures to ensure the security of your personal data,
Not to pass on personal data to the other parties, unless this is necessary for carrying out the purposes for which they were provided,
to be aware of your rights regarding your personal data, to make you aware of them and to respect them.

Why do we process personal data

Your personal data are processed by the company for the following purposes and legal grounds:

To participate in the activities of the company (performance of agreement).

To send newsletters and invitations (consent data subject).

For the above purposes, we may request the following personal data from you:

Personal identity data: name, first name, address, mail address, phone number, information about the purchased product.

We use the collected data only for the purposes for which we obtained the data.

Communication to third parties

The company may communicate your personal data to its distributors and to service providers of the company, any processing being done under the control of the company in the context of the purposes set out above. These third parties will be bound by the same privacy obligations at all times.

For example, we use a third party for:

Provision of the internet environment (web hosting).

Taking care of the IT infrastructure

Taking care of and distributing newsletters and invitations

The distribution of the company's products

We never pass on personal data to other parties with whom we have not concluded an agreement.

Of course, we make the necessary agreements with these parties to ensure the security of your personal data.

Furthermore, we will not pass on the data you provide to third parties, unless this is required by law.

We do not provide personal data to parties located outside the EU.

In the event of a sale, merger, reorganization, restructuring, dissolution, or similar event relating to the companies' business or assets, your personal data may form part of the transferred assets.

You have the right to object to the above and the firms will no longer process this information upon your request.

Retention period

The company will not retain your personal data longer than necessary for the purpose for which it was provided than required by law. As a general rule, personal data will be kept for a maximum of 5 years after its last use. If you have made a purchase from the company, your contact data for this purchase and other data necessary for the execution of this purchase agreement will be kept for 10 years or as long as the warranty runs on the product.

Data Security

We have taken appropriate technical and organizational measures to protect personal data of yours from unlawful processing, for example, we have taken the following measures

All persons who have access to your data on behalf of the company are bound to secrecy,
We maintain a username and password policy on all our systems,
We make backups of personal data in order to recover it in case of physical or technical incidents,
We regularly test and evaluate our measures,
Our employees are informed of the importance of protecting personal data.

Your rights regarding your data

Complaints

You always have the right to file a complaint with the Privacy Commission, this is the supervisory authority in the field of privacy protection.
